Social Media Sites Data Protection Policy

Purpose/s for collecting data:

All data collected on this site is processed in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (EU) 2016/679, and any other law/regulation to which the National Blood Transfusion Service may be subject to. Recipients of data:

Employees who are assigned to carry out the functions of this Department, access the information you give us. Personal Data posted on social media sites may be disclosed to third parties.

Third Party Access:

Information provided by you on this site may be accessed by third parties for processing and collation purposes while this is being prepared and handed over to the Malta National Blood Transfusion Service.

Your rights:

You are entitled to know, what information the National Blood Transfusion Service holds and processes about you and why; who has access to it; how it is kept up to date; what the Department is doing to comply with its obligations under the General Data Protection Regulation (EU) 2016/679.

The General Data Protection Regulation (EU) 2016/679 sets down a formal procedure for dealing with data subject access requests, which the National Blood Transfusion Service follows.

All data subjects have the right to access any personal information kept about them by the Department, either in electronic or in manual files. Requests by data subjects are to be addressed to the Data Protection Officer of the National Blood Transfusion Service. Your identification details such as ID number, name and surname and address must be submitted with the request. In case we encounter identification difficulties, you may be required to submit an electronic copy of an identification document such as the Identity Card, driving license or passport, which copy will be returned after identification is established.

The National Blood Transfusion Service aims to comply with requests for access to personal information within one month from date of receipt of request, unless there is good reason for delay. When a request for access cannot be met within the stated timeframe, the reason will be explained in writing to the data subject making the request.

All data subjects have the right to request that their information be amended, erased or not used in the event the data results to be incorrect. If applicable, these rights may be limited in accordance with Data Protection and Privacy Legislation. If you are not satisfied with the response you have given to the request for access, you can refer your complaint to the Information and Data Protection Commissioner, whose contact details are given below.
